2. Implementation of Anti-Red Tape Act	The DILG monitors compliance of the LGUs on RA 9485, the Anti Tape Act of 2007. The law required LGUs to formulate citizen's charter which will serve as guide of clients on the processes involved in availing particular services. It is the intention of the law to eliminate red tape in government transactions by improving its frontline services and streamlining its transactions/processes.
