Considering that significance of this correspondence, it is also the duty of your respective DILG field officers to personally hand-in these letters to the concerned local chief executives.

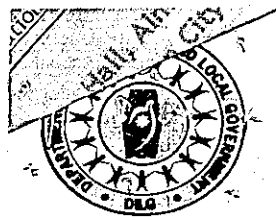

SUBJECT : OFFICIAL LIST OF SGH RECIPIENTS, CY 2012

This refers to the assessment results of the CY 2012 Seal of Good Housekeeping which covered 74 provinces, 136 cities and 1,431 municipalities nationwide. Out of these, a total of 60 provinces, 107 cities and 1,205 municipalities passed the SGH for both 2012 (Silver Grade) and 2011 (Bronze Grade) criteria.

In your area of jurisdiction, 76 out of the 77 local government units qualified with a breakdown as follows:

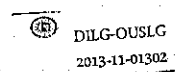

MEMORANDUM

TO : DILG REGIONAL DIRECTORS, PROVINCIAL AND CITY DIRECTORS, AND ALL OTHERS CONCERNED

SUBJECT : SEAL OF GOOD HOUSEKEEPING REFERENCE PERIOD AS BASIS IN ACCESSING NATIONAL PROGRAM WINDOWS

This refers to the inquiries we are receiving regarding the policies on programs that are linked to the SGH assessment results, namely:

- Special Local Road Fund or SLRF pursuant to *Memorandum dated Nov. 25, 2013*;
- Payapa at Masaganang Pamayanan or PAMANA;
- Grassroots Participatory Planning and Budgeting, formerly known as Bottom-Up Budgeting or BuB; and
- Sagana at Ligas na Tubig sa Lahat or SALINTUBIG.

pursuant to *DBM-DILG-DSWD-NAPC Joint Memorandum Circular No. 3, Series of 2012, DILG-OPAPP Joint Memorandum Circular No. 1, Series of 2012, DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2013-143, and Memorandum dated November 8, 2013*

Questions normally raised are on the reference period of SGH results as part of eligibility requirement of LGUs to access the said programs, whether to use 2011, 2012 or 2013 results.

Considering that there is no SGH Assessment for 2013, it has to be clarified that the reference period to be used is the most recent SGH results. For 2014, the reference period to be used is the 2012 SGH results until such time that the new assessment results are released.

Further, SGH Certification for purposes of availing the above-mentioned programs does not require the USLG signature. Instead, refer to the official list of SGH recipients posted in the DILG Website. However, in the case of LGUs that passed after the assessment period, SGH Certification issued by USLG is required pursuant to the DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2014-13 entitled: *Issuance of 2012 SGH Certificates to Local Government with "After Assessment Compliance" for Purposes of Accessing Loan or Other National Program Windows*.
