Subject: AVAILABILITY OF NDDRMF, NDRRMP AND NCCA PLANS

IN THE DILG WEBSITE

Republic Act No.10121, otherwise known as the "Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010" was signed into law on February 1, 2010. Sec. 2 (e) thereof, provides that the government shall develop, promote and implement a Comprehensive National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Plan (NDRRMP) that aims to strengthen the capacity of the national government and local government units together with partner stakeholders to build the disaster resilience of communities, and to institutionalize arrangements and measures for reducing disaster risks, including projected climate risks, and enhancing disaster preparedness and response capabilities at all levels.

Republic Act No. 9729, otherwise known as the "Climate Change Act of 2009" also provides for the formulation of a National Climate Change Action Plan (NCCAP) (Section 13) and Local Climate Change Action Plan to reflect changing social, economic and environment conditions and emerging issues (Sec. 14).

The formulation of the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Plan (NDRRM Plan) started right after the approval of the NDRRMF by the Executive Committee of the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (NDRRMC) on June 16, 2011. The Plan serves as the translation to the National DRRM Framework officially indorsed by the four Vice-Chairs, National Disaster risk Reduction and Management Council (NDRRMC), per provision of RA 10121. A parallel effort was also made on the preparation of the National Climate Change Action Plan (NCCAP) spearheaded by the National Climate Change Commission (NCCC), which was approved by President Benigno S. Aquino III on November 22, 2011.

To better guide local governments in identifying priority actions on disaster risk reduction and management and climate change adaptation, the Department has uploaded in its website (www.dilg.gov.ph) the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Framework (NDRRMF), National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Plan (NDRRMP) and the National Climate Change Action Plan (NCCAP).

All DILG Regional Directors and Field Officers are hereby directed to cause the immediate dissemination of this Memorandum Circular within their respective areas of jurisdiction and provide necessary technical assistance to LGUs.
